## Payments and charges

- ✓ It is our practice policy to give patients full information about the cost of their dental work before any treatment is undertaken. A full price list can be obtained from Reception.
- ✓ A written estimate and treatment plan will be provided for all dental treatment.
- ✓ You may pay for your dental care by cheque, cash, or credit/debit card.
- ✓ We try to make payment as straightforward as possible. Our policy is that patients are expected to pay for their treatment at the first appointment prior to commencement of treatment; the only exception to this is for crown, bridge and denture work where the final balance will be payable at the impression appointment.
- ✓ Future appointments will not be made until payment has been made in full.
- ✓ Any late payments could be subject to administration charges
- ✓ A Dental Care Plan is available at the practice to help spread the cost of treatment into monthly payments.
- ✓ An interest free payment plan is also available (ask reception or your dentist for further information)
